## **Internships at WHCA**

WHCA is now accepting applications for interns who want to assist a dynamic community media organization in accomplishing its mission to inform, enlighten, and entertain cable subscribers in Whitman and Hanson. Our internship program offers a well-rounded experience for currently enrolled students. It also aims to continue building on the interns skills by letting them earn real world experience in the television production field. Previous television experience is preferred.

### **Our program offers students:**

- A chance to learn and use the latest editing software.
- The ability to lean in a hands-on, low-pressure environment.
- The opportunity to provide a valuable community service to those in Whitman and Hanson.
- The chance to become your own producer and share your interests with those in Whitman, Hanson, and beyond.
- A platform to build a resume, demo reel, and/or job application material.

### **Duration, schedule and credit for internships:**

- Interns must be available for a minimum of 3-4 hours a week and a maximum of 20 hours a week.
- Credit will vary from school to school. Please check with your advisor for specifics.
- Duration can vary based on the need of an intern or institution. Typical internships are about 3 months long. Internship terms will be mutually agreed upon before the start of the internship
- Hours and availability must be flexible in order to accommodate those we serve: the Whitman and Hanson communities.

### **Curriculum:**

Interns will work with WHCA staff to create dynamic programming for the Whitman and Hanson communities. Interns will complete a series of projects that give them experience in multiple areas of television production. Our internship program is written loosely to adjust to the dynamic nature of community media and to adjust to the requirements of the intern's institution.

### **Areas of focus:**

During the internship students will refine their skills in the following areas:

- Field Production
- Digital Video Editing
- Studio Production
- Outreach, Publishing, and Graphic Design
- Producing (managing a production from start to finish)
